Course Schedule Planning for Next Academic Year (Fall & Spring)

- Before registering for courses, all students are required to meet with their departmental faculty advisor for course/schedule approval.
- Students without approved courses/schedule will have a “registration hold”.

Advising Appointment and Procedure

1. Sign-up for an advising appointment with your ECE advisor.
2. Review the course flowchart or four-year plan for your major.
3. Use your program *Flowchart Advising form** to *mark (X)* the courses you have taken and *circle* the courses planned for next year.
4. Use the *Course Schedule Plan form** to list your courses by semester for your next academic year (Fall and Spring). *Pay close attention to prerequisite course requirements and to courses that are offered only in the Fall or Spring semesters.*
5. Bring your completed Flow Chart Advising Form and the Course Schedule Plan Form to your advising appointment!

Important points on Graduation Requirements:

- ✓ A 2.0 GPA in major courses (ones that appear on the graduation clearance form).
- ✓ Completion of one GE course designated as ethnic (E) and one as non-western (NW).
- ✓ Select your upper division thematic carefully. Since both degree programs in our department are considered high unit majors (with a theme modification), make certain that you choose two courses from the correct areas. Refer to http://www.ecst.csuchico.edu/depts/ce/documents/UD_Theme_Mods.pdf to determine which courses you should select from. Consult with your faculty advisor or the university advising office if you have any questions.
- ✓ Apply for graduation one year prior to your planned graduation date.
